Summer Time

Summer doesn't bring quiet time to the food service department. We have some stuff to do to make sure next year goes well.

This year will bring prepping a brand new kitchen at the new Rossford Elementary School. June 14 and 17 head cooks will get together to prepare the kitchen for its pre-licensing inspection.

On June 18 we will have to present a kitchen that is ready for operation. Everything must be working and functioning as if we are going to serve. After everything is approved we can then license the kitchen.

Summer work doesn't end there though. The building will need a brand new HACCP Policy. A HACCP policy is a set of written instructions for the proper use and function of a kitchen. This policy is kitchen specific, so

our old policies will need updating to reflect our new kitchen and equipment.

At the beginning of July we are able to complete an application with the State of Ohio for operating a School Nutrition Program. This is a yearly process. We can then also post and begin approving free and reduced applications for the 2019-2020 school year. We will complete a Direct Certification in July as well. Students who qualify for benefits through Direct Certification do not need to fill out a paper application. Parents are notified by the end of July if their students qualify through this process.
