A Message from Dr. Neiderhouse, Principal

Welcome to the Second Semester!

We are a few weeks into the second semester and I am proud of the improvements students have made thus far this school year. In particular since October, students have reduced their tardies to school and between classes by 27% both at the junior and senior high level. This has demonstrated students are starting to learn what it means to be "Ready" to learn! Students have also improved their behaviors as there are approximately 1/3 less behavior incidents in January than October. While we are still striving for more progress, the students are showing us they know what it means to be "Respectful" and "Responsible." If you see the pictures on page two, you will notice that students that had at least a C average and did not have a discipline referral for the first semester earned their way to a fun event in the gym filled with inflatables for a class period.

Our parent advisory council has met three times this year and will meet again on March 6 at 6:30pm. We reviewed the December Family Survey results and plan to take the next step to create actionable steps to start planning for next school year. We welcome other families that want to join us. We want to acknowledge a couple of staff changes that have occurred in January. Mrs. Wehrmeister, high school counselor, resigned due to personal reasons and Mrs. Wagner, 7th grade teacher, retired on January 31. Both positions will be filled with long-term substitute positions to finish off the year. Both have served the district and students for many years and we will miss them both immensely!

Also by the end of this month, we will be wrapping up the winter athletic season. We encourage all of our athletes to finish the season off strong! In the coming weeks, we will email out a second semester incentive for students to continue to be in attendance and on time to school and class. This incentive will ideally create additional motivation for our students as they lock in their focus on the Ohio State Tests coming up in April. Starting on page four we want to recognize and congratulate our 2nd quarter honor roll students!

Counseling Corner



- PowerSchool Parent Portal: Use the SafeArrival website via the SchoolMessenger link in PowerSchool Parent Portal online. Log into the PowerSchool Parent portal then scroll down and click on the SchoolMessenger link on the left.






