Gilbane, as the construction manager of the downtown and elementary school construction project, will be providing you with updated information on our projects through our newsletter, The **Gilbane** Gossip. This newsletter will be hand delivered on a quarterly basis to our immediate neighbors as well as posted to the District's website to help keep everyone informed on the overall progress and upcoming activities.

The Glenwood Elementary project is underway and full steam ahead! The building pad wrapped up towards the end of May with concrete foundations following behind and tracking to be complete by mid-June. Underground plumbing and site utilities are underway. The Gymnasium CMU block walls are ongoing and tracking to be complete the first of July. Over the remaining summer months, prior to the return of students, the first phase of classroom renovation in the existing wing will be complete and will give the students and staff a taste of what their new building will look like.

You may start to notice some activity on the downtown High School site by mid-June. The construction fencing will commence and site contractors will start to mobilize. The abatement contractor will be mobilizing and working throughout the month of June. The structural demolition contractor will be mobilizing towards the end of the month to start the selective demolition of the 1922 building which is tentatively scheduled to start the week of July 9<sup>th</sup>.

Again, our team appreciates the opportunity to work with your district and community on this exciting project.
