Officer William A. Miscannon Scholarship	Describe why you are interested in law enforcement.
Private Stephen Machcinski and Private James Dickman Memorial Scholarship	Describe your desire to become a firefighter.
Tall Timbers Foundation Scholarship	Identify the name and company of the Tall Timbers employee and explain why you should be the recipient of this scholarship.
Toledo Automobile Dealers Association Scholarship	Identify the name of the employee, which dealership he/she is employed by and your relationship to the employee.
