**COMMUNITY:** A suburban community of approximately 6,000 residents located southeast of Toledo on the banks of the Maumee River extending into the countryside.

SCHOOL: Public comprehensive high school enrolling 613 students in grades 9-12 with 165 attending vocational school. School population: 80% White, 3% Black, 6 % Latino, 9% Multi-racial. Approx. 50% Econ. disadvantaged. The staff totals 34 teachers. Rossford High School uses an alternating block schedule (2020-21 only Hybrid Block schedule).

<u>CURRICULA:</u> Curriculum includes business, college preparatory, vocational, advanced placement, special education, honors courses, College Credit Plus, and independent study. Honors and AP points are used in figuring averages, which determines rank. All juniors are required to take a full credit in Government.

Honors curriculum includes: Eng. 9,10,11, Algebra 1,2, Geometry, Pre-Calc, Calculus, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Human Physiology, World Geography, World History, Spanish 4

AP curriculum includes: US History, US Gov/Politics CCP courses taught at the high school include: UToledo ENGL 1110, ENGL 1130, SPAN 2140, SPAN 2150, Owens CC CLW 105, and UFindlay MTH 141
